# Removing a License From Sentinel ACC Manually

**1** – To remove a license, first the Sentinel License Manager service must be stopped, to do so:


### Windows 7

Open your Services window by entering "services.msc" on your run line.



## For Windows 8/8.1

Go to the tiles screen, click the search and type in service.msc. Then click the search result.



#### For Windows 10

Click the search spyglass or the cortana symbol. Type in Services and click the Services Desktop app.




**2**. Find and select Sentinel Local License Manager (or Sentinel LDK License Manager)



- **3**. To ensure you have the correct service open, confirm the service name is "hasplms"
  - 4. Starting or Stopping a service:
- A) To stop the service, push the Stop button, and change the Startup Type to Disabled. (See the red markers below)
- B) To start the service, push the Start button, and change the Startup Type to Automatic. (See the green markers below)

**5**- Now that the service is disabled , the license could be removed, navigate to:

## C:\Program Files (x86)\Common Files\SafeNet Sentinel\Sentinel LDK\installed\24790

You'll see a list of files there , delete only the files starting with they key that has expired.

3- After that re-start the Sentinel License Manager service again or re-start the computer.
